#### **Button Layout**

#### Opening the App

 From the homescreen of the FireTV navigate to the YourTV Green app and open it using the Directional Pad and the Select button. If you are not on the home screen pressing the Home button on your remote will bring you to it.



### Navigating the Guide

• Use the Directional Pad (Dpad) to highlight TV and the Select button to select it. This will open the channel guide

 Once you are in the guide you can use the Up and Down buttons on the Dpad to change channels, and the Left and Right buttons to scroll through the timetable of the guide. Once you have a channel highlighted, clicking the Select button will bring up a short description.



• Clicking the Select button again will then open the channel in fullscreen.

 When a channel is in fullscreen mode pressing the Select button will bring up playback controls. The playback controls can be used to pause, restart, and/or record the current channel/show. The Up and Down buttons on the Dpad can also be used to surf between channels in fullscreen.



- Pressing the Menu button on your remote when in fullscreen will bring you back to the guide. The channel number and name are displayed on the left of the guide with a symbol next to it that indicates if the channel supports recording and playback.
- In this example, channel 6 will allow recording, 7 will allow recording and playback, and channel 8 will allow neither.

#### Managing Recordings

 With the guide open, use the Dpad to scroll ahead of the current time to a channel you would like to record. Once you have the show/movie highlighted use the Select button to bring up the description, and press the Select button again to view the recording controls.



• From here press the Select button while RECORD is highlighted to bring up the recording options for that program. If it is a series you can choose to record the show whenever it is on, only on a certain channel, only one episode, etc.



With the guide pulled up pressing the Back button will open the app's sidebar. From here you can scroll down to recordings using the Dpad. This is where all the recordings can be found; sorted between Programs, series, and future recordings. At the top of this screen will be the nDVR Quota. You have a maximum of 50 hours' worth of recordings and this will show your remaining time out of the 50 hours.



• Using the Dpad and Select button you can watch, cancel, and delete recordings from this screen.
